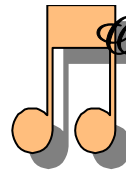

- ~ Appointments must be scheduled at least two working days in advance. Your appointment must be no earlier than 9 a.m. and no later than 2 p.m.
- ~ Be ready 1 ½ hours prior to your appointment.
- ~ If you need the wheelchair accessible van, please let us know when you schedule your appointment.
- ~ The service is curb to curb, so if you need assistance, you must have a caregiver, age 18 or over, to accompany you. The driver cannot be responsible to offer assistance.

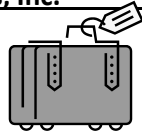

This 6 day, 5 night trip includes:

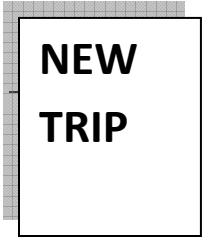
