A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR EXTENSION OF DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA (DORA) DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2023, the City of Canal Winchester Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (DORA) began operation; and

WHEREAS, the application for the DORA specified that its hours of operation would be Thursday to Sunday, from 12:00p.m. to 11:00 p.m., and on Labor Day from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to Section 4301.82(F) of the Ohio Revised Code, desires to extend the hours of operation to include Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANAL WINCHESTER, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the public health and safety requirements in the application for the Canal Winchester DORA be revised such that the DORA's hours of operation shall be Monday through Sunday, from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

Section 2: That the Clerk of Council and other officials and employees of the City are hereby authorized and directed to take such further action as is necessary, including notification to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control, to implement Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.

**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MEMBERS OF THE MADISON TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND FAIRFIELD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, protection of public safety is a core value of the City of Canal Winchester; and

WHEREAS, at the opening Friday night high school football game between the Canal Winchester City Schools and Groveport Madison Local Schools, hosted by Canal Winchester High School on August 18, 2023, an incident occurred in which four individuals were apprehended following a fight outside gates and three firearms were confiscated; and

WHEREAS, the three confiscated firearms had been modified to have automatic firing capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the efforts of officers of the Madison Township Police Department and deputies of the Fairfield County Sheriff's Office prevented further violence, injury, or worse to spectators and participants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANAL WINCHESTER, STATE OF OHIO:
