

ORDINANCE NO. 21-007

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRAWSER PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2021 STREET PROGRAM PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Municipal Engineer and the Construction Services Administrator to award the contract for the 2021 Street Program Project to Strawser Paving Company, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Council hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City of Canal Winchester to enter into a contract with Strawser Paving Company, Inc. for the 2021 Street Program Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANAL WINCHESTER, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and hereby is, authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Canal Winchester with Strawser Paving Company, Inc. in the amount of \$745,280.00 for the 2021 Street Program Project.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare, such an emergency arising from the need to meet a specific construction schedule; wherefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.



Summary of Bids Received and Award Recommendation

Dear Mr. Sims,

We have completed a review of the bids received on February 5th, 2021, for the above referenced project. I am providing herewith, a "Summary of Bids" received and a Bid Tabulation.

A review and tabulation of the bids received reveals that the lowest bidder is dependent upon a combination of alternates. Strawser Paving Company has been verified to have submitted the lowest base bid in the amount of \$685,690.05. Their alternate bid amounts were \$75,419.00 and \$59,589.95 respectively for Alternates 1 and 2. Strawser Paving Company would remain the low bidder with selection of the Base Bid and either alternate bid. However, Columbus Asphalt Paving Inc. becomes the lowest bidder if the Base Bid and both alternates are selected. Their total of all three bid components is \$818,086.25 which is \$2,612.75 less than the combined bid remitted by Strawser Paving Company. The attachments illustrate all bids received with more detail.

We have completed a review of the bids received for the above referenced project. As a basis for determining the successful bid, consideration was given to the contractor who could demonstrate a permanent place of business, possession of suitable equipment to complete the work, experience, positive performance on similar projects, and the lowest bid. Due to the dependency of the low bid upon alternate selection, the bids received by both Strawser Paving Company as well as Columbus Asphalt Paving Company were reviewed considering the preceding criteria. Both companies positively demonstrated meeting or exceeding the defined criteria. Furthermore, both companies have performed numerous successful projects in recent years for the City. Therefore it has been concluded that the lowest and best bidder is dependent on the selection of bid alternates.

It is recommended that should the City choose to award the contract for the base bid and either alternate, the award be made to Strawser Paving Company. Should the City select the base bid and both alternates then it is recommended that the award go Columbus Asphalt Paving Company.

The City is advised to conduct a legal review of the bid from the chosen contractor and to ensure that they adequately complete all forms prior to execution of the contract. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you should have any additional questions.
