Description: The WSRLA Water Main Replacement Project is a state funded project to improve waterlines in the following areas:

Dye/Manor Subdivisions: Aging water mains on Woodsvie Dr., Mohican Dr. and Cherokee Dr. will be replaced. Existing water services will also be replaced to the water shut off box in the front yard. There will be some short-term interruptions of water services as tie-ins to existing mains and services are made. Notices of specific dates and times will be provided in advance. Once the waterline work is complete, street resurfacing will take place for Mohican, Cherokee and Cherokee Cts. Woodsvie Dr. will be reconstructed with new curbs and driveway approaches. *See information regarding the 2023 Street Program for more details on the roadway work.*

Groveport Rd.: Aging waterline will be replaced from Washington St. to just east of Gender Rd. There will be some short-term interruptions of water service as tie ins to existing mains and services are made. Notices of specific dates and times will be provided in advance.

Gender Rd.: Waterline will be installed from W. Walnut St. to the water tower north of the RR tracks. There will be very limited short-term interruptions of service to make connections to existing facilities. The service interruptions will be coordinated with each business.

Lithopolis-Winchester Rd.: A new water main will be installed from McGill Park to E. Columbus St. to create a new loop in the water system. There are no anticipated interruptions to existing services.

Traffic and Access Impacts:

Access for emergency services will always be maintained.

Dye/Manor Subdivisions: Traffic will be maintained. On street parking will be restricted to provide adequate and safe work areas. Drive access will generally be maintained. There will be some limited access interruptions while work is being performed immediately in front of your property. Notices of expected interruptions will be posted by the contractor.

Groveport Rd.: Traffic will be maintained. There will be times of lane restrictions on Groveport Rd. One Lane two-way traffic will be controlled by flaggers at these times. Drive access will generally be maintained. There will be some limited access interruptions while work is being performed immediately in front of your property. Notices of expected interruptions will be posted by the contractor.

Gender Rd: Traffic will be maintained. There will be some lane restrictions during construction. Signage and flaggers will be utilized to control the traffic. Any interruptions of drive access will be coordinated with each business.

Schedule: The project is anticipated to begin construction in June and be complete by December. Work in the Dye/Manor Subdivisions will occur first.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. **Will there be interruption of my water service?** It will be necessary to have short-term interruption of water service to your home in order to connect the new waterline to you existing service at the Right of Way. This process usually is less than an hour. You will be notified in advance of this interruption. It is not uncommon that when the service pressure is reduced and then re-applied, minute debris in the homes plumbing and water tank can be stirred up and get caught in the screens of the water meter and the fixtures. Members of the Water Department staff will be available during the service switch overs to help trouble shoot any pressure or volume issues that may result from the reconnection.
